



SUMMER CAMP GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

We are very excited to move forward with our summer day camp plans. We want to ensure the safety of our staff and students and follow the protocols outlined by the ministry of health with regards to the running on summer day camps. Please see below some guidelines and procedures with regards to how our summer day camp will look this year.

1. Each child and staff attending summer camp will be screened at the beginning of each day with a questionnaire and temperature check.
2. There will be 3 rooms running with 1 teacher and 9 students in each room (co-horts of 10 individuals).
3. Students will remain in their assigned co-horts throughout the whole week and will not be mixing with other co-horts at any-time throughout the day.
4. Each co- hort will have access to their own washroom which will be not be shared between co-horts.
5. Washrooms will be cleaned and disinfected after each use.
6. Increased cleaning of common areas.
7. Hand sanitizer stations will be available at entrance into the studio along with each room and the front desk.
8. Staff will ensure all students wash their hands with soap and water before and after eating snacks and lunch and before and after participating in daily activities.
9. No snacks will be provided by the studio or can be shared among students.
10. Each student will have their own designated box to leave their stuff in during the day. Changerooms will be closed for the time being.
11. Markings on the floor for each student to participate in for daily activities.
12. No spectators will be able to enter the studio to observe classes. This also means we will not be able to run a showcase like we usually do at the end of the week. We want to continue to ensure the safety of all of our dance families.
13. Students will be participating in theme days, arts and crafts, games, jazz and hip hop.
14. All students will be asked to bring both outdoor and indoor shoes.
15. A schedule of daily events will be emailed to each registered student the week before the camp.
16. A waiver will be needed to fill out the first day of the camp and be dropped off by each participant.
17. All children must be picked up and dropped off outside. Children will be picked up by our staff at drop off and brought into their designated space. Children will be brought out to you at pick up. If raining, parents will be asked to remain in their vehicle and call the studio once they have arrived.
